YOUR USE OF OUR BLOG NETWORK

We ask that you:

- Keep comments to the subject matter of the post on which you are commenting.
- Don't post anything that contains any material that is abusive, vulgar, obscene, hateful, fraudulent, unlawful, threatening, or harrassing towards any person whether a user on this blog or not.
- Don't plagiarize.
- Don't defame others.
- Don't use posts to promote products or services.
- Don't use third-party content without permission unless you are permitted to do so by copyright law.
- Don't post any material which may be discriminatory or cause offence on the grounds of an individual's sex, race, religion or belief, ethnic or national origin, sexual orientation, age, marital status, disability or working status.

- Don't upload, post, transmit, or make available, any material that contains viruses or any other computer code, programs or files designed to destroy, interrupt, or limit the functionality of any computer software or hardware or telecommunications equipment.

You can complain about any comments that break the guidelines by emailing office@stjameschristleton.org.uk. We will seek to respond to or act on all complaints within 48 hours.

COPYRIGHT AND THIRD PARTY RIGHTS

- You own the copyright to the material you post as a comment, but you agree to grant us perpetual, royalty-free, non-exclusive rights to publish your entry on any media.
- You agree that you will not use our blogs to post any copyright material or intellectual property that is not your own without the express permission of the copyright or intellectual property holder unless permitted by copyright law, in particular permitted as fair dealing (e.g. short quotations from a text for the purpose of criticism).
